## SOME INFORMATION ABOUT THE LONDON-BASED STUDY ON HARMFUL PRACTICES/VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Imkaan is a national second-tier charity dedicated to the development of the Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic and Refugee (BAMER) Violence Against Women and Girls sector.

We have been commissioned by the Greater London Authority (GLA) to carry out a study on violence against women with a specific focus on BAMER women and harmful practices. We have been asked to explore forced marriage, female genital mutilation, 'honour-based violence,' other customary beliefs and traditions and their links to violence.

The study will aim to identify and report on harmful practice in London, its prevalence, and a key element of the project will be to identify existing and emerging best practice and gaps in relation to existing services and support.

The purpose of this survey is to map existing service provision within London so that we can establish level and types of services available across London and identify best practice and gaps in current provision.
